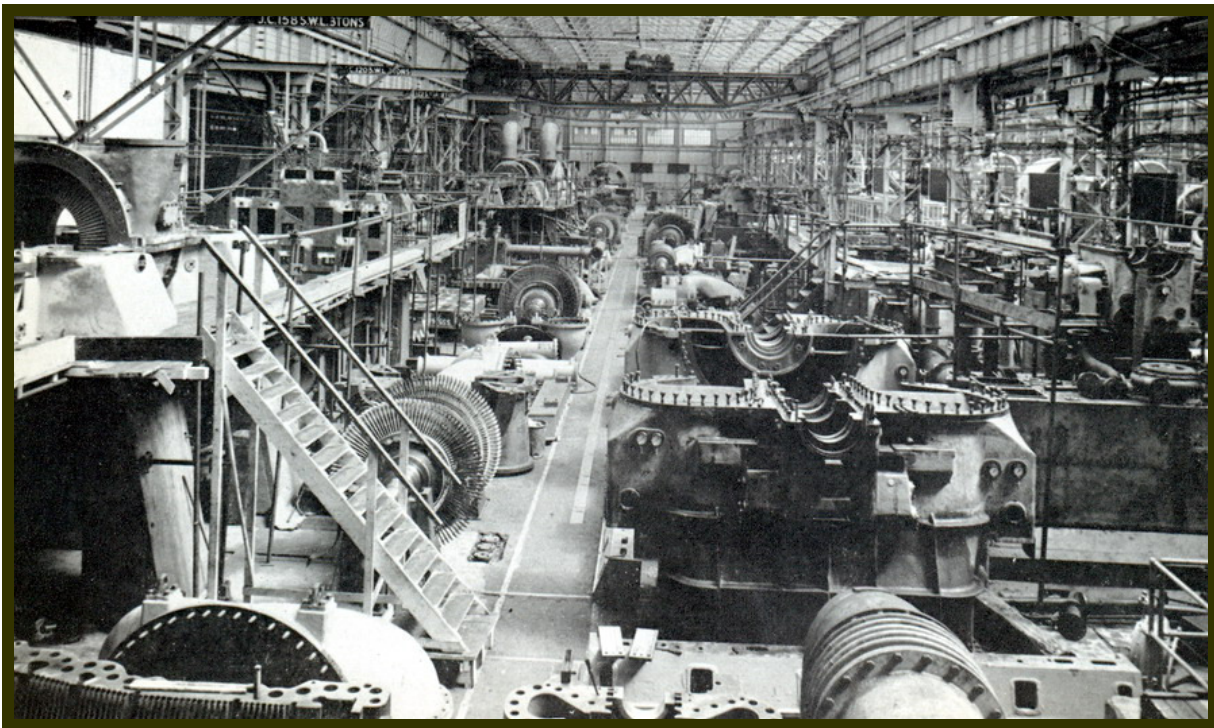
Assembling single-package commercial and heat pump units at Borg-Warner's Central Environmental Systems Plant in Norman, Oklahoma, 1982

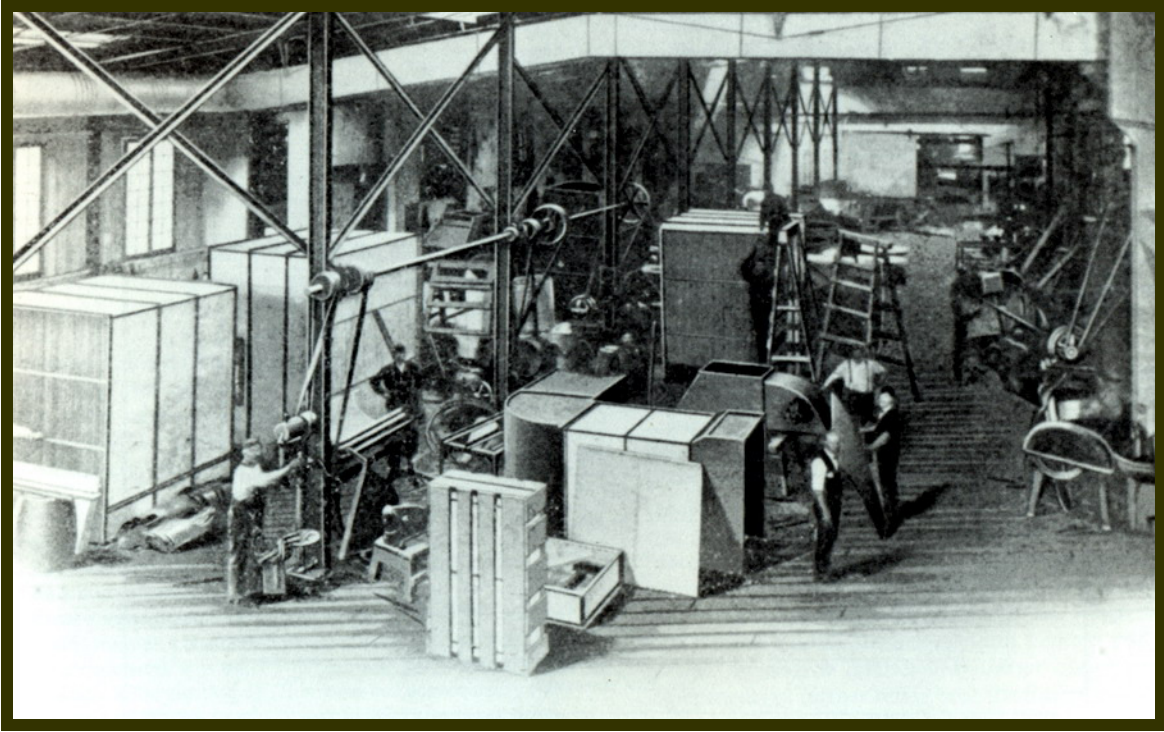

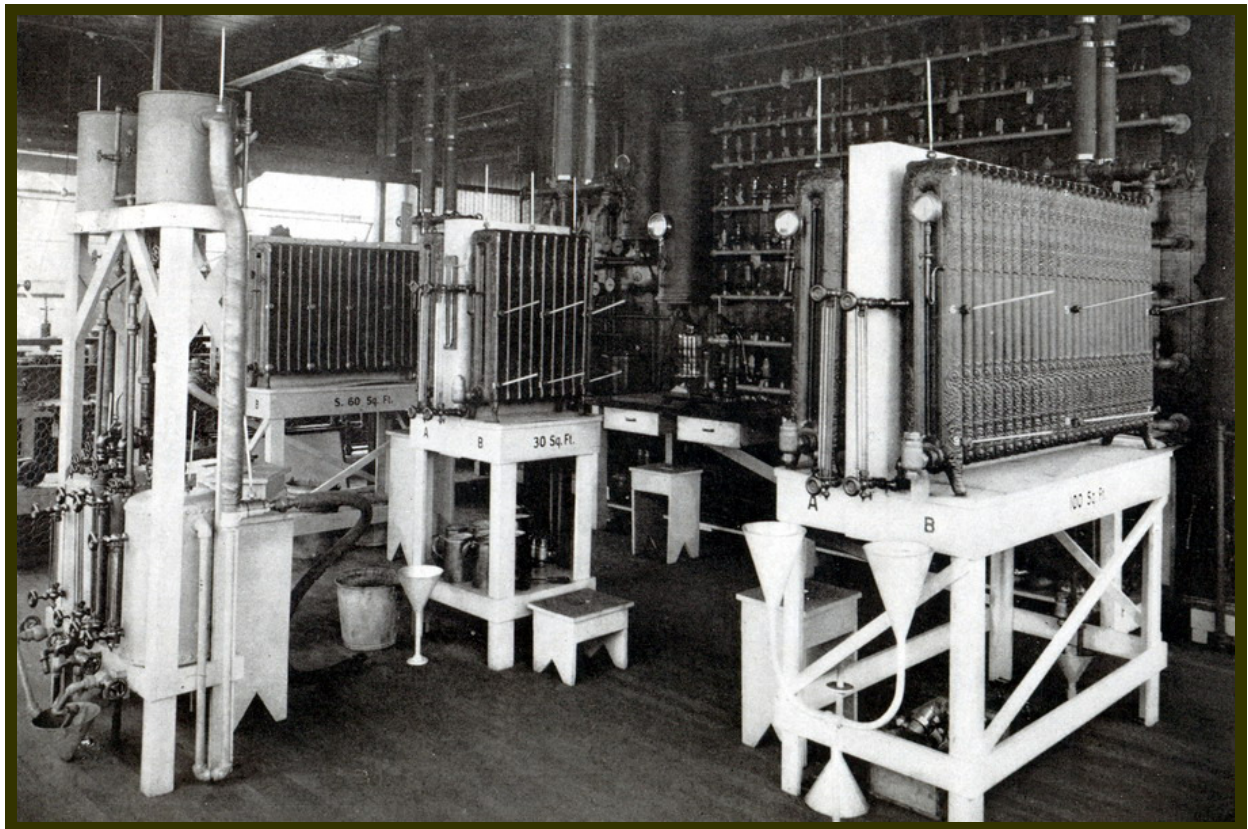

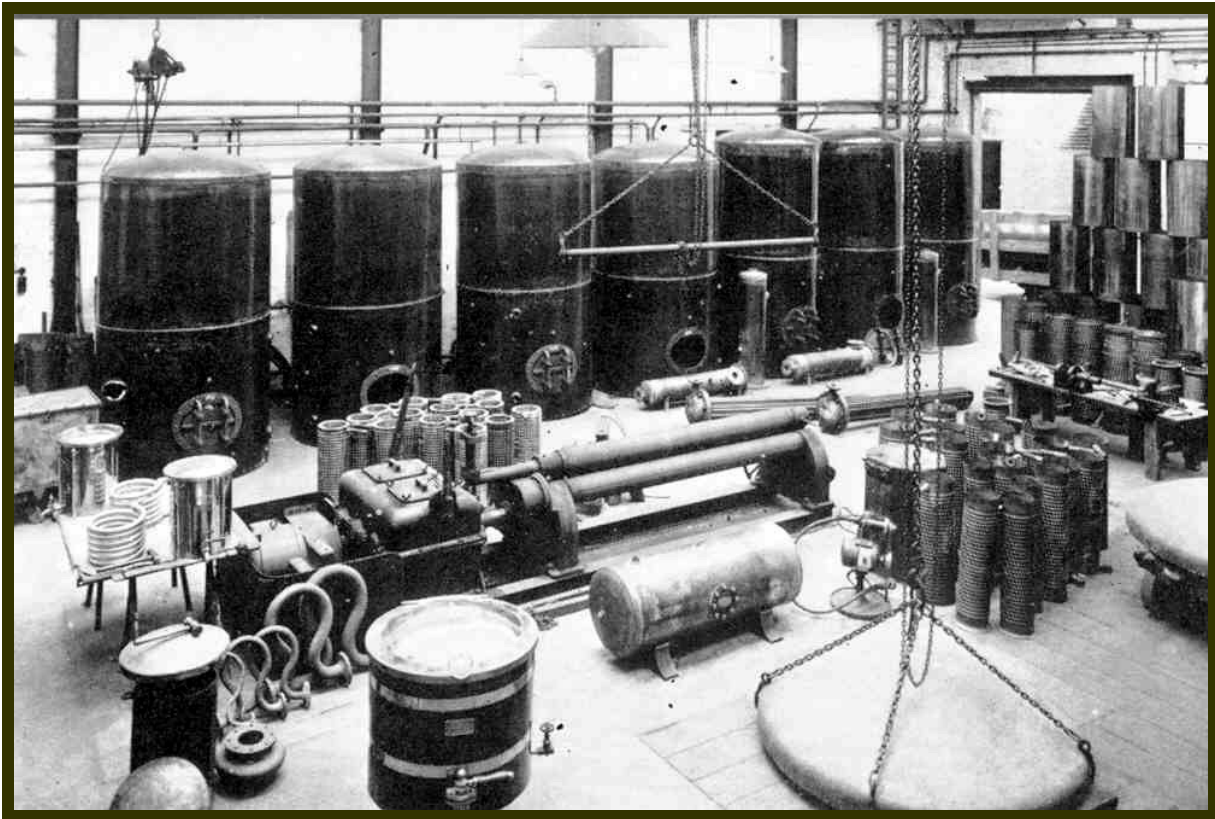

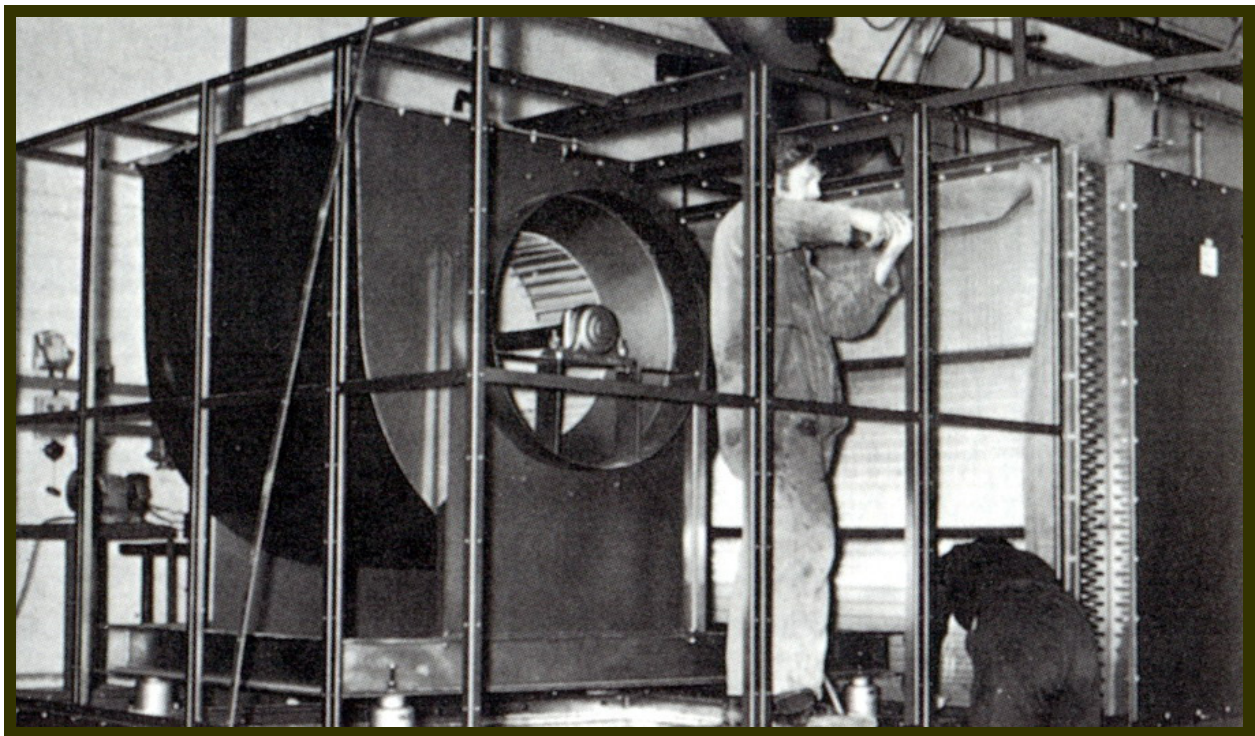
