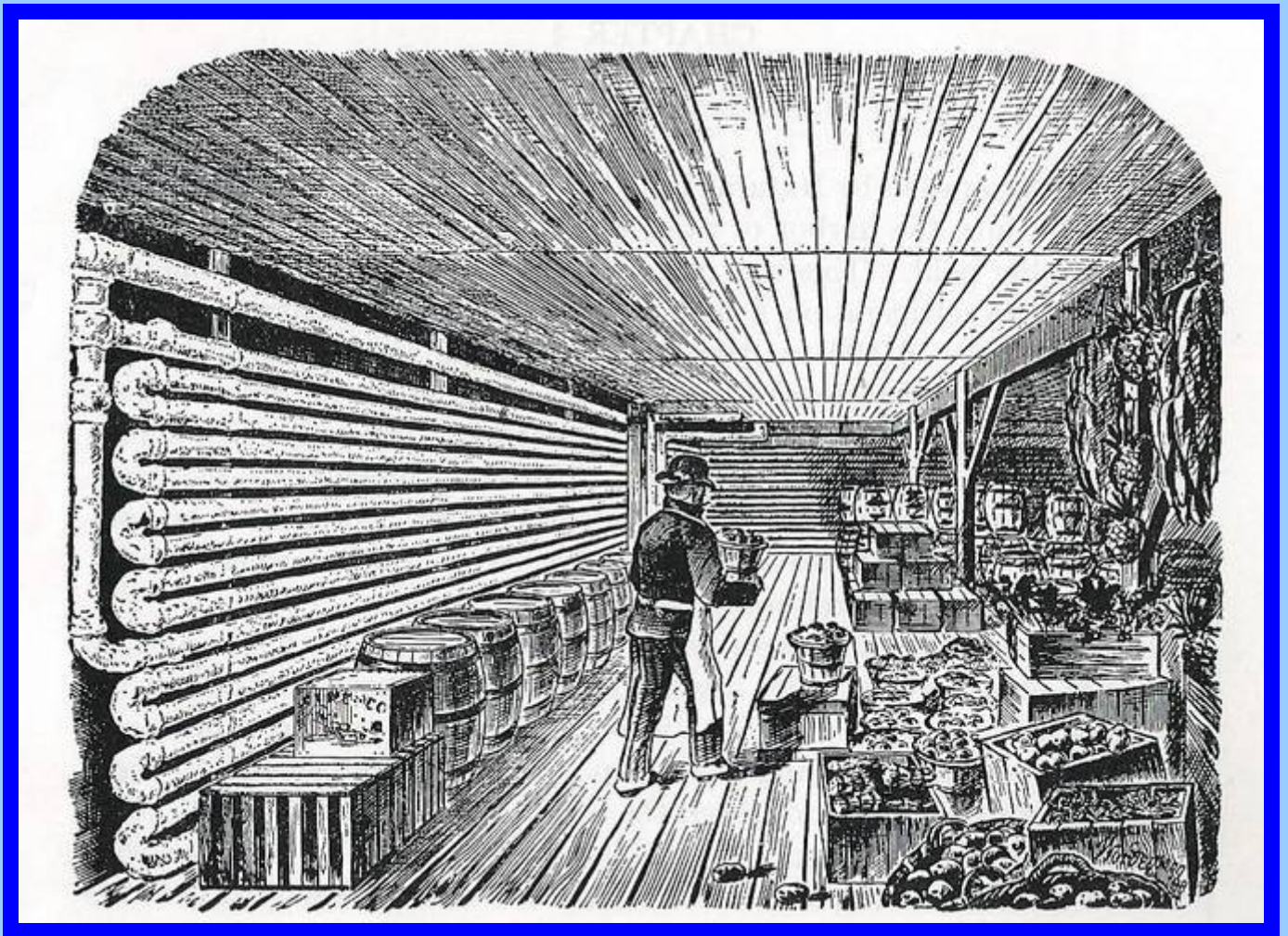
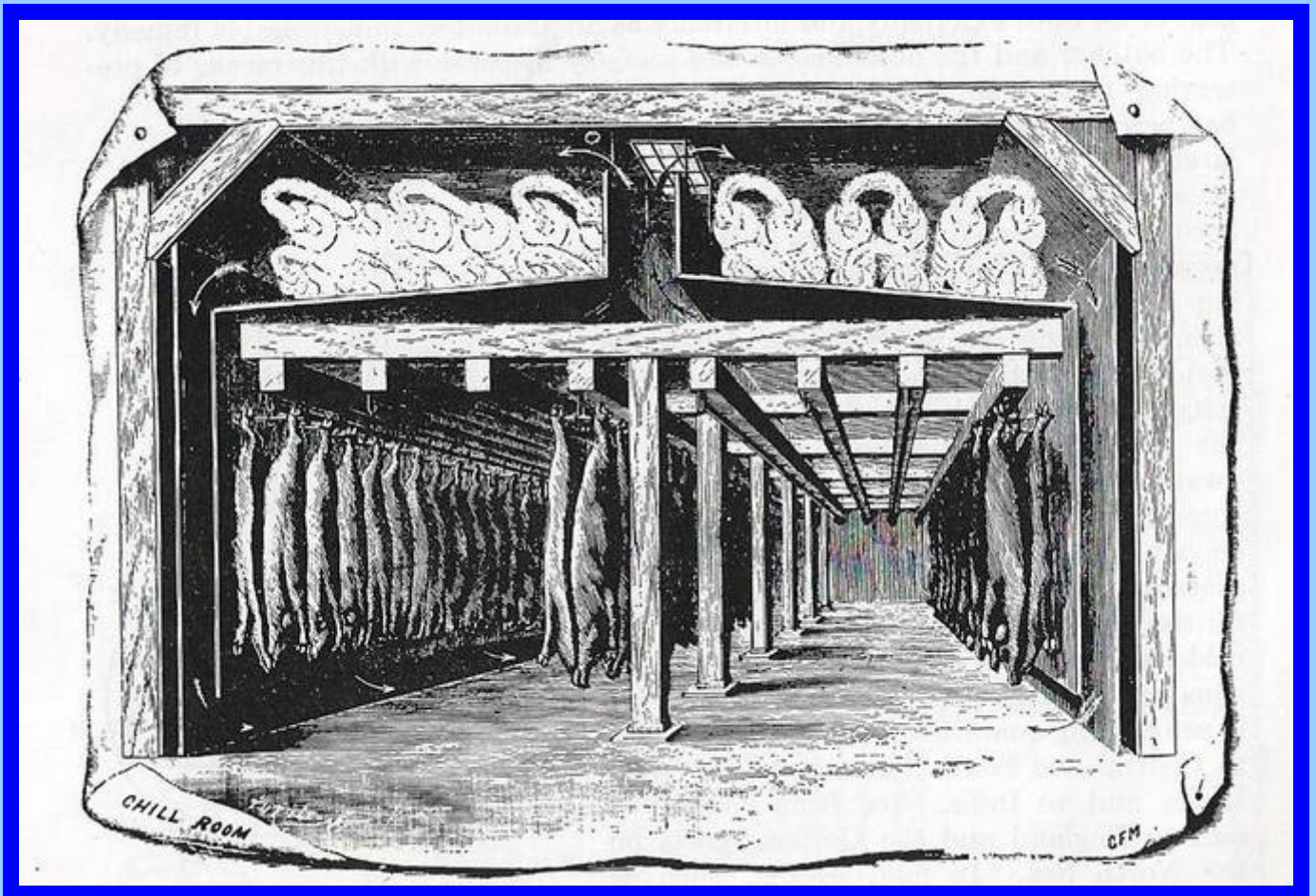


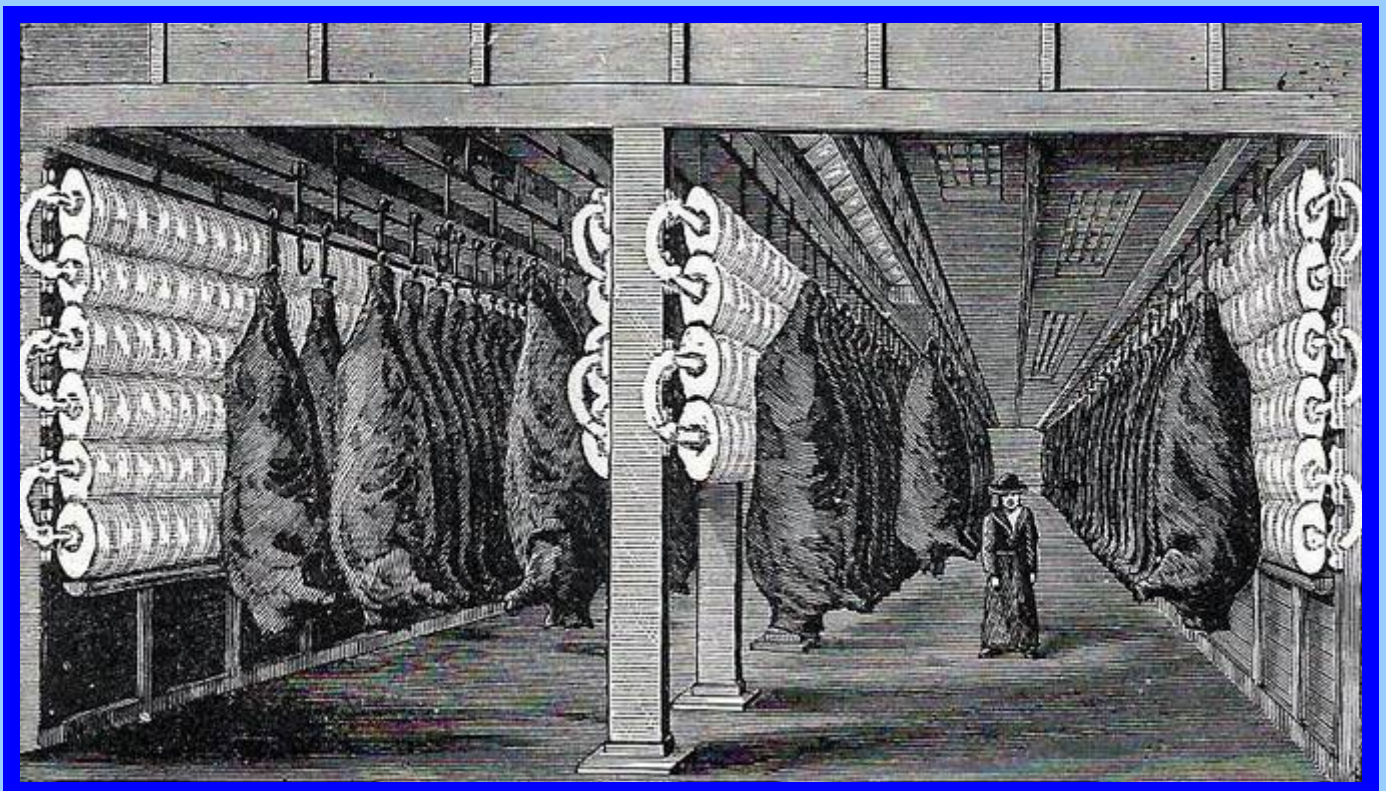

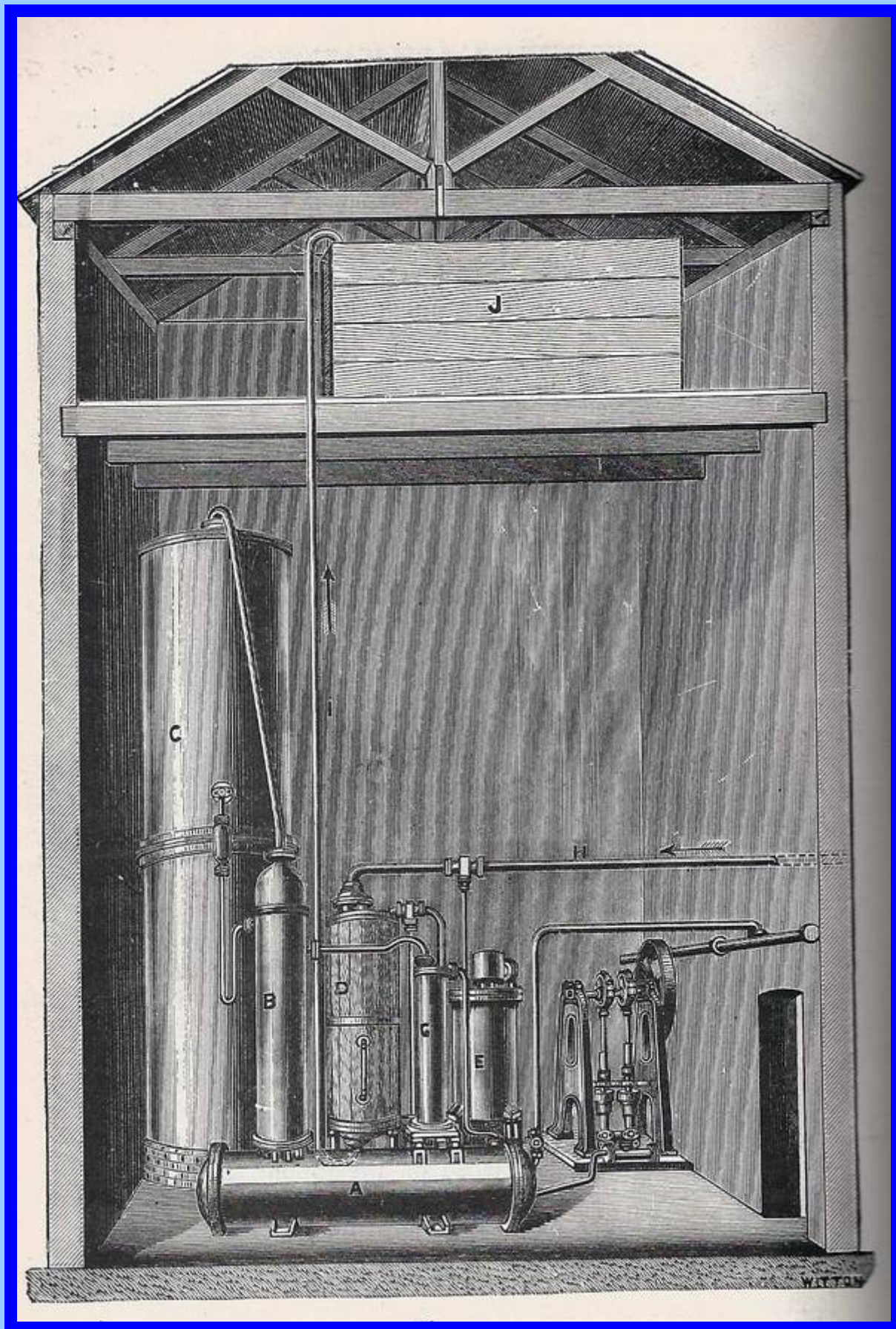
Early American cold storage from an 1890 Frick catalogue



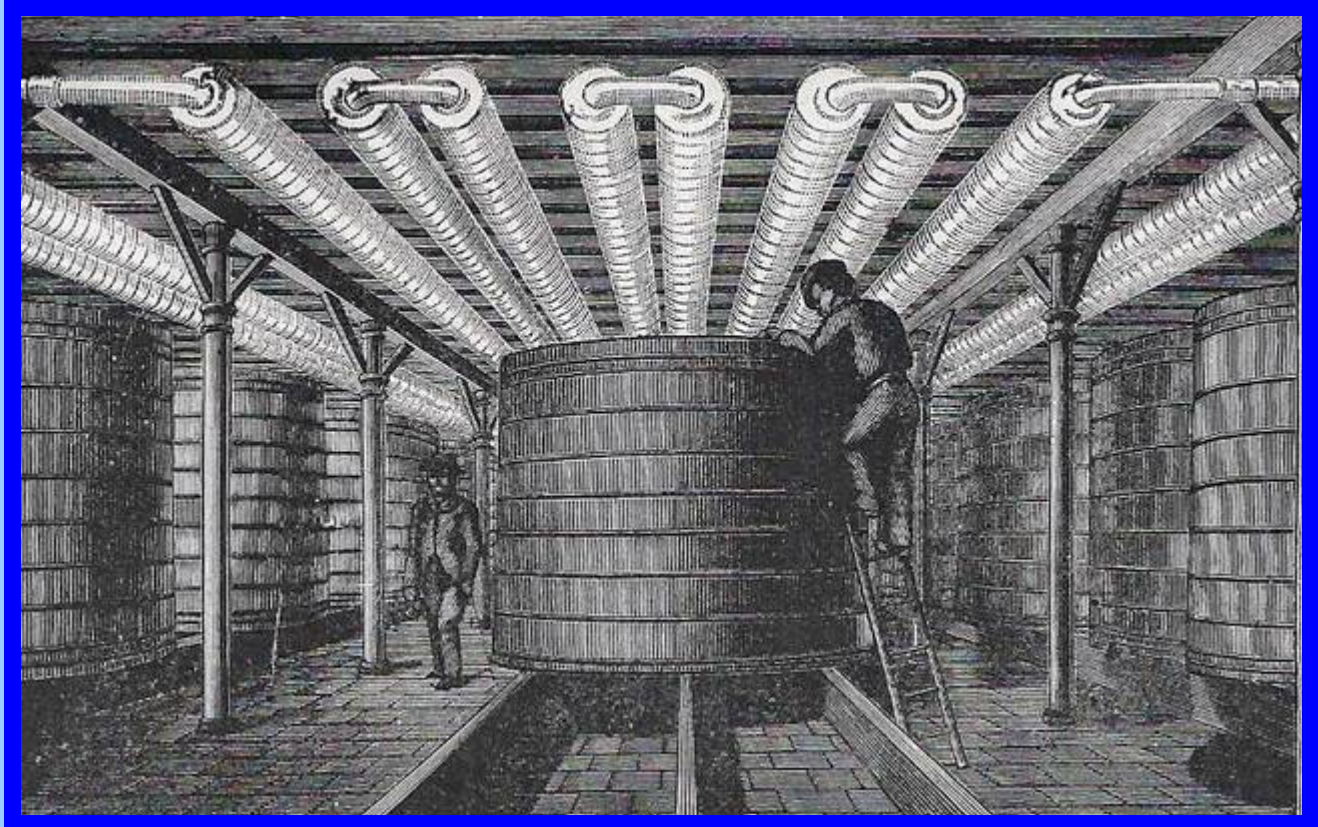
*American woodcut of cold store from an 1890 De La Vergne catalogue.
Note the cast-iron disks, serving as fins, on the cooling coils.*



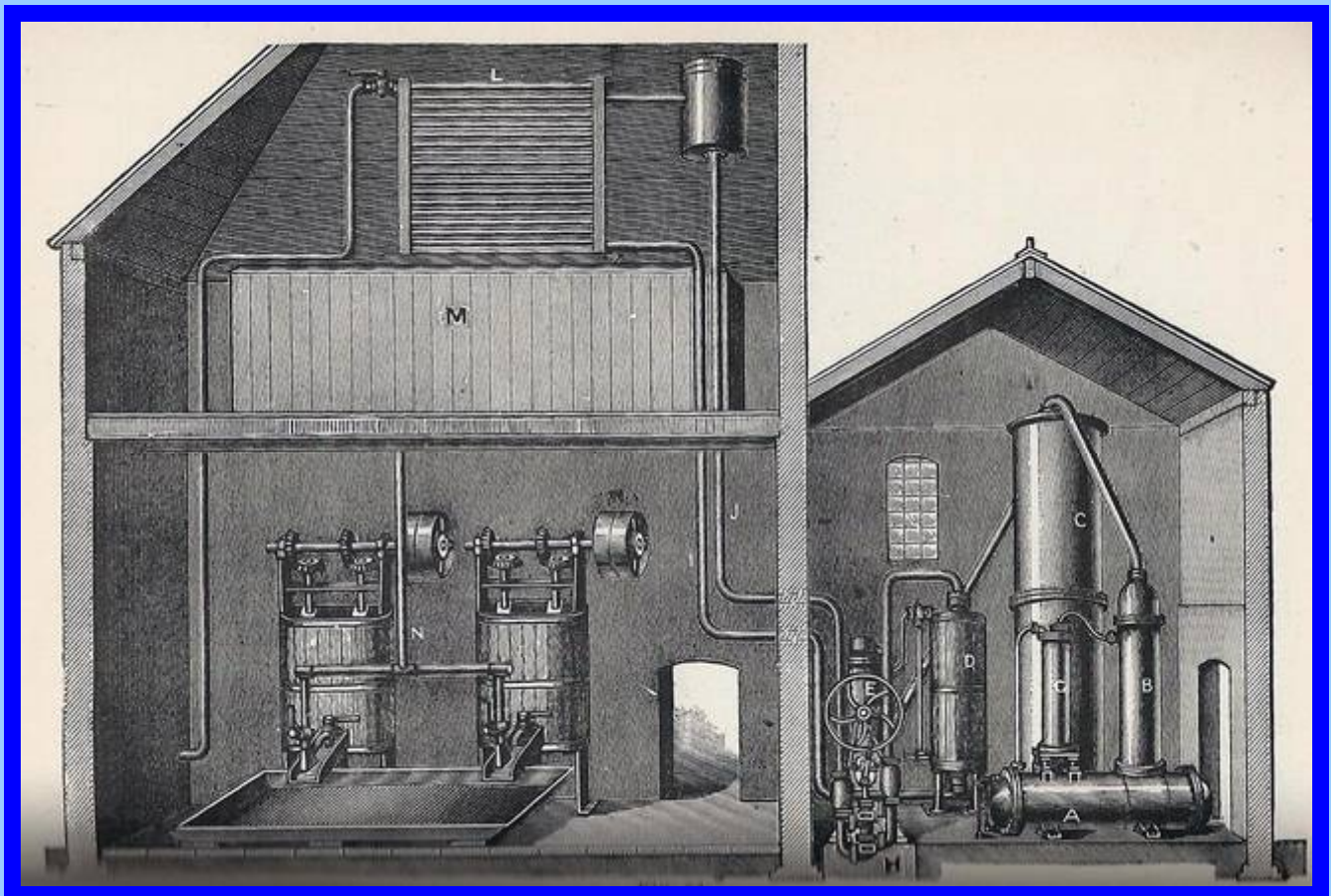
Beef chill room fitted with De La Vergne patent pipe system, 1902 handbook



Pontifex-Wood ammonia absorption machine 1902



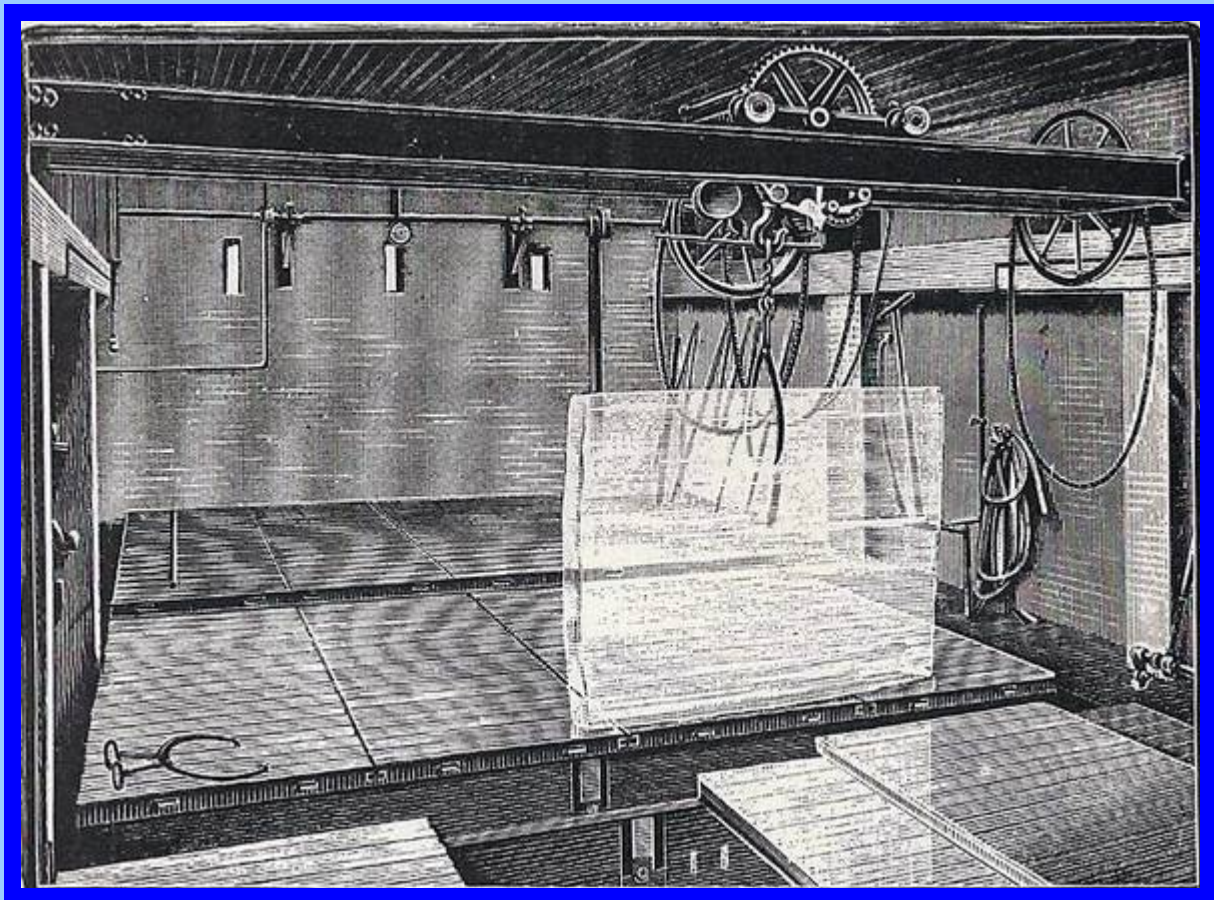
Cooling a fermenting room by De La Vergne system, 1902 book
